Intake Process

You can call 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Needed rides can be scheduled 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Call at least five days in advance of your appointment. Have specific documents ready when you call (Medicaid number or Medicaid Plan ID, date and time of appointment; pick up and drop off addresses, etc) Virginia Department of Medical Assistance Services

If you have Fee-For-Service (FFS) Medicaid, Managed Care Organization (MCO), Commonwealth Coordinated Care (CCC), or Commonwealth Coordinated Care Plus (CCC+) you may be eligible for Non-Emergency Medical Transportation (NEMT) services. This service will take you to Medicaid-covered services such as medical and health care appointments, supported employment, and day support programs.

- Please note that not all Medicaid plans have transportation benefits.
- Non-Emergency Transportation services vary in each community.
