Greensville County and the City of Emporia have combined resources to provide transportation for residents and visitors to improve the quality of life. The Greensville Emporia Transit (GET) system is designed to provide an efficient and effective transit route that connects residents with employment, education, healthcare, essential government services, shopping, and recreation through transit services within a one-hour timeframe. The bus is equipped with a wheelchair lift. A rider must be at least 14 years of age to ride alone.

GET operates a fixed route from 7:00 am until 7:00 pm Monday through Friday. The route can be found on the website. Tokens can be used instead of exact change. Tokens can be purchased at:
